Our meals are made fresh each day and all delivered within a 15mile radius of our state-of-the-art kitchen. We source many ingredients locally. We only use Free Range Eggs. We can trace all of our meat and fish back to its source. All fish is MSC. All our beef mince comes from farms in Sussex as do our yoghurts. We supply fresh 50/50 bread daily. We are reducing the amount of sugar in our menus by providing yoghurt and fruit 3 days and cakes and puddings only 2 days per week. Primary children in West Sussex now have on average 65% less sugar in their school meals compared with 3 years ago. Our food is GM free. There are no 'hidden nasties' in our food only hidden
